- I keep going when things get difficult.
- I can challenge myself.
- I can work independently when I get stuck.

### Reflective (purple):

- I can talk about my work and behaviour.
- I can suggest ways to improve.
- I know when I've done well and when I could have done better.
- I can question what I am learning about.
- I can look at my feedback to improve my work.
- I can consider links in my learning.

- I can aim to be the best I can be.
- I can achieve my target.
- I can challenge myself to be better.
- I can aim high.
