



Year 6 Curriculum – Half-term 2

English

In English we will be writing :

- Formal email
- Short narrative 1: description which creates atmosphere.
- Short narrative 2 : Integrating dialogue
- Personification poems





Maths

In maths, we will be learning about fractions, decimals and measures.

We will be working out the fraction of an amount as well as adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions.

We will be revising how to add and subtract decimals as well as multiplying and dividing and solving word problems involving decimals.

We will be converting units of measure and solving problems involving area and perimeter.

In Reading we will be focussing on the following:

- 7 Pre-reading strategies: I wonder, VIP, Text to the World, First Aid, GIST, I Predict, Visualise.
- Texts I wonder, Pauper Pete, Blitz Boys, In the Company of a Thief, City Jungle (Poem), Owl (poem), Different types of WW2 Shelters (Non Fiction)
- Focussing on test style questions Tabulated, Vocabulary – meaning, find and copy.



Also this half-term	
Science	The children will name the parts of the circulatory system. They will learn about the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.
	They will learn how the human circulatory system works and how nutrients and water are transported around the body. They will also find out about the advantages of a healthy lifestyle.
History	The children will learn about Medieval African Kingdoms, in particular the two kingdoms of Ethiopia and Benin.
Geography	The children will be learning about the location of Ethiopia in Africa and also its climate, landscape, population, biomes, major cities and rural life.
Religious	The children will learn about Christianity. That Christians believe God and that this can be understood as the father, son and ho
Education	spirit (Holy Trinity). That the actions of all three, show what God is like in the Bible.
Music	Traditional West African drumming sessions using the 'Djembe'
Spanish	In Spanish lessons we will be consolidating our learning from last half term (greetings, numbers from 1-10 and colours) and completing the end of unit assessment.
Computing	In our computing lessons we will be writing code to create games. We will detect errors and debug algorithms.
PSHE	We will understand how to recognise who we can trust and who not to trust. To know how to judge when a friendship is makin us feel unhappy or uncomfortable and how to manage conflicts. To be aware of how to seek help or advice from others, if needed.
