5 ways to prepare your child for school

Help your child to begin to cut up their own dinner and eat independently.



Begin to teach them to recognise their own name when it is written down. If you want to teach them to write it then a capital letter is only used for the first letter in school.

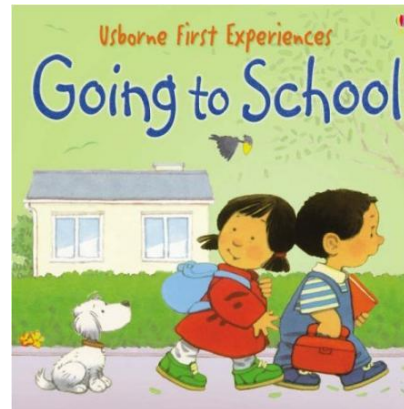

Buy and **label** your child's uniform.

Encourage your child to become more independent. Can they take off and put on their own shoes and coat? Can they take themselves to the toilet?



Talk positively to your child about starting school.

This is a chance for you to talk with the teacher about what happens when your child starts school, any concerns you might have, what you need to be prepared like uniform and about what your child likes and enjoys to do at nursery or home.
