


Year 2 Curriculum - Half-term 1

English

Maths

Numbers to 100

This term we will concentrate on various aspects of numbers to 100. Pupils will be able to count to 100 through different steps, including counting up in tens. Place value will have a major role throughout the chapter. Pupils will also look at comparing numbers using their placevalue knowledge and they will be ensuring their number bonds are secure.

In Reading, we will be reading a wide range of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will be using our pre-reading skills to help us unlock the text.

Science	In Science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats
