

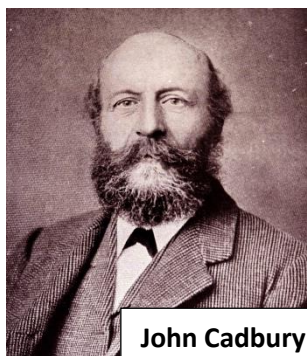


# Year 1 Curriculum – Half-term 2

## English

In English, Year 1 will be busy writing lots of text types this half term. We will be writing an onomatopoeia poem about fireworks, an information text about John Cadbury, instructions to help us make hot chocolate and a letter to Santa!

**We will be learning how to use exclamation marks (!), time conjunctions (first, next, then and finally), conjunctions (and, but, so) and continue learning about adjectives ( e.g. the **small** cat).**



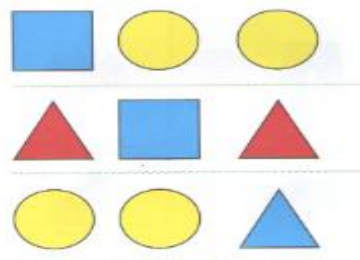

<b>History</b>	<p>We will be learning about the Victorian Era.</p> <p>The children need to know all about Victorian schools and how different they are from schools today. He is the gentleman responsible for playgrounds being built in schools.</p>
