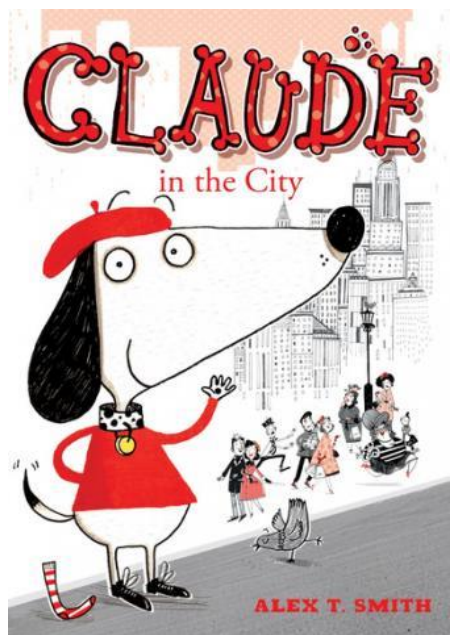




# Year 2 Curriculum – Half-term 3

## English

In our literacy lessons this half term we are reading the book, 'Claude in the City,' which links really well with our Street Detectives. Claude, the main character from the story, will be teaching us about the features of a postcard and then we will plan and write our own postcards as Claude telling of his adventures in the City.



## Maths

### Money

Pupils will be reviewing concepts on writing and counting money in addition to extending their knowledge of how to represent money using £ and p.

### 2D Shapes

This chapter focuses on 2D shapes and their different properties. It also explores how to draw shapes, make patterns with shapes and turn shapes using familiar language.

Our PE topic is Gymnastics this half term.

In Reading, we will be reading a wide range of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will be using our pre-reading skills to understand the text better.

## Also this half-term

<b>Science</b>	In science this half term we will be learning about - How plants grow in the winter.
<b>History</b>	We will learn about changes that have taken place in the local area and how these changes have impacted on the local environment. We will also learn about significant people and events in the local area.
<b>Geography</b>	We will learn how fieldwork can help to answer questions about the local environment and can include observing or measuring, identifying or classifying and recording.
<b>Religious Education</b>	This half term we will learn about Hinduism. We will ask and research questions like What is God like? We will learn about The story of Durga, and other important aspects of Hinduism.
<b>Music</b>	In music we will Perform using our voices and sing a variety of songs with more accuracy of pitch and sing words clearly and breathing at the end of phrases.
<b>Computing</b>	In computing we will learn how to programme an animation to react to pressed keys.
<b>PSHE</b>	We will be learning about being safe and where to get advice, internet safety and harms.
