



Year 5 Curriculum – Half-term 5

English

In English, we will be creating a promotional leaflet for a theme park and also consider how a radio advert is different and try different language to attract potential listeners.

Your child will also be given spellings every week. Please help them practice as much as possible.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning about percentages, geometry and position and movement.

Keep practising times tables and the four written methods, there will be the final set of PIXL tests in May.

Reading

In Reading, we will be reading a wide range of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will be using our pre-reading skills to understand the text better.

Also this half-term

Science	This half-term we will be learning about the human life-cycle, comparing with other mammals and dependency on others.
History	In the coming weeks, will learn about the Lady of Mercia, looking at: Viking raids, Wessex alone, Mercia and Wessex unite, rebuilding Mercia and braver and bolder Mercia.
Geography	In Geography we will learn about north and South America, mainly concentrating upon the Favelas of Brazil, but also looking at the weather differences in America.
Religious Education	In RE we will finish our 'Living Christian traditions.' Topic.
Music	Keeping Healthy - create a textured original composition including an ostinato and drone.
PSHE	To know the facts about legal and illegal harmful substances and associated risks, including smoking, alcohol use and drug-taking.
