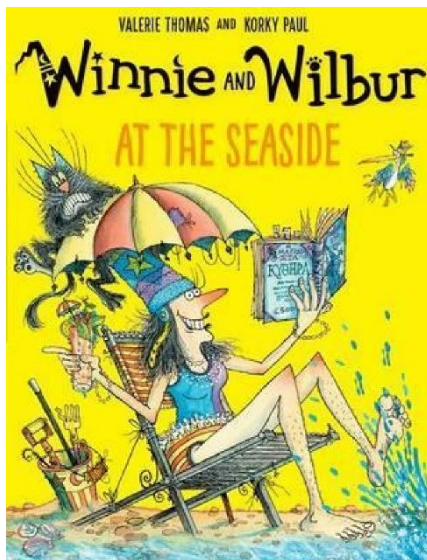




Year 2 Curriculum – Half-term 1

English

In our literacy lessons this half term we are reading 'Winnie at the Seaside' which links in with our Beachcombers topic. The children will then be writing rewriting the story. After visiting Hunstanton beach, the children will write a beach description focusing on adjectives.



Maths

Children will be focusing on place value and numbers to 100. During lessons, they will look at partitioning numbers and particularly focusing on tens and ones. This knowledge will then help the children to add numbers using column method. Pupils will also look at comparing numbers using their place-value knowledge and they will also go through number bonds.

Reading

In Reading, we will be reading a wide range of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will be using our pre-reading skills to understand the text better.

Science	In science we will be learning about the differences between things that are living, dead and never been alive and different habitats. Children will also learn about different food chains and learning key terminology such as 'prey, predator'.
Geography	Children will learn about different features of a beach. They will also describe the size, location and position of a physical feature, such as beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley and vegetation.
Religious Education	Children will learn about Buddhism. They will learn about key events such as Losar and different symbols associated to the religion.
PSHE	Children will be learning about strategies in making new friends.
