Much of our work will be preparing the children for the timestables assessment. Please practice up to 12x12 as much as possible at home!

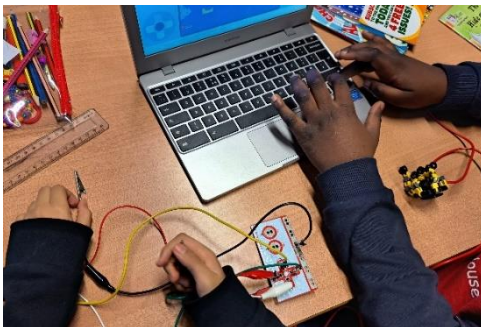
PE & School Sport
